

Investigator: Medicaid Fraud Control Unit (MFCU) - Syracuse

The Office of the Attorney General is seeking qualified candidates for Investigator positions located in various locations in the State. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

MFCU is the centerpiece of New York's effort to investigate, penalize, and prosecute individuals and companies responsible for improper or fraudulent Medicaid billing schemes. In addition, the MFCU is the only law enforcement agency in the state specifically mandated to investigate and prosecute abuse and neglect of residents in nursing homes, hospitals, and other facilities that provide care to unrelated adults. **The qualifications for this position are: experience investigating employees of nursing facilities and the elderly residents of those facilities; experience interviewing suspects resulting in court admissible confessions; experience preparing and executing search warrants; experience qualifying witnesses who provide sworn affidavits; experience providing criminal court testimony as a witness to facts and circumstances; experience working cooperatively on investigations with all levels of law enforcement; experience conducting undercover investigations using conventional and electronic surveillance techniques; certified, with extensive experience in the administration of polygraph examinations; established contacts and liaisons with local, State and Federal agencies in the area served by the Syracuse MFCU office.**

Qualifications in addition to those listed above:

Must have at least fifteen years of law enforcement experience with at least ten years as an Investigator and current NYS basic police school certification.
