

## **Criminal Investigator: Investigations - Albany**

The Office of the Attorney General is seeking a highly qualified and dynamic candidate for the position of Investigator for the greater Albany, New York region. Candidates should be hard-working, motivated and committed to public service on behalf of the people of the State of New York.

Investigators, under supervision, conduct detailed investigations of the circumstances, facts and conditions connected with complaints and violations of the law, using the highest level of independent judgement and discretion. These are often highly complex and sensitive criminal matters which cross county lines, involve organized crime and public corruption. Successful candidates will combine traditional investigative skills with current technological skills, coupled with strong interpersonal skills and the ability to work in multi-disciplinary teams to bring cases to completion.

This position performs investigations in a wide variety of criminal cases in various bureaus throughout the Office of the Attorney General in the greater Albany region. **The qualifications for this specific position include: A Bachelor's Degree in a criminal field from an accredited institution preferred; experience holding the rank of lieutenant or higher, responsible for overseeing the daily operation of a police force; experience in protective detail of high-level officials; expertise in interviewing and interrogation skills; extensive experience in the investigation of confidential and sensitive matters; experience investigating corruption matters; experience conducting surveillance operations; experience in obtaining and executing search warrants; experience in interaction and coordination with other law enforcement agencies; must have established law enforcement contacts in the Albany and surrounding counties area.**

### **Qualifications in addition to those listed above:**

Must have at least ten years of law enforcement investigative experience and current NYS basic police school certification.

Performance of the duties may require frequent, unscheduled work on evenings and weekends.
