The [Environmental Protection Bureau](#) in the Office of the New York State Attorney General (OAG) is seeking a mid-level attorney for its Albany office. Applicants should have a minimum of two (2) years of experience litigating environmental, energy, or similarly-complex cases in state and federal courts and agencies.

Excellent writing, research, and critical analytical skills are essential, as is the ability to develop and complete litigation and policy initiatives. Candidates should have litigated affirmative and defensive cases involving judicial review of administrative actions, rulemakings, and adjudicatory proceedings and experience in building cases in evolving public policy or technical areas. Applicants should identify their experience in energy, environmental, public health and safety, natural resources, land use, and/or commercial cases. Former judicial law clerks are encouraged to apply.

In addition, the applicant must demonstrate a commitment to public service and the ability to work well with members of the public, scientific or technical staff or witnesses, and administrative agencies. The position could involve representing the State on energy, environmental, and public health matters before federal or state courts and administrative agencies (e.g., NY Public Service Commission, US DOE, FERC, NRC, EPA).

Applicants must reside in (or intend to soon become a resident of) New York State and be admitted to practice law in New York State. In addition, the Public Officers Law requires that attorneys in the Office be citizens of the United States. This full time position is for the Albany office.

Candidates from diverse backgrounds are encouraged to apply. The OAG is an equal opportunity employer and is committed to workplace diversity.
